Wisconsin

The SAVE Act will hurt eligible and registered voters in **Wisconsin**:

Percent of residents of **Wisconsin** with a US passport: **43.1%**

Number of women in **Wisconsin** with a different the last name than their birth certificate: **1,316,546**⁸⁹

Percent of voters in **Wisconsin** that voted by mail in 2024: **16.6%**

Actual number of vote by mail ballots in **Wisconsin** in 2024: **575,257**

Does **Wisconsin** have a Real ID that confirms US citizenship? **No**

Note, for the five stats that provide a Real ID with citizenship confirmation, it often requires additional fees and paperwork.

In the 2024 election cycle, **705,403** in **Wisconsin** registered to vote or updated their voter registration using various methods:

- **151,736** at an elections office
- **49,895** by mail, email, or fax
- **356,696** online
